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Commandments for Teachers at KIDUCATION.

Ensure that any and every activity involves as many of the 5 senses as possible.

Ensure that every child gets a chance to be part of each learning-teaching experience.

Ensure that your classroom environment is non-threatening for children.

Be understanding with children, understand their needs, their development and temperament.

Ensure that there is a balance in activities that are child directed and teacher directed.

Always use open-ended questions to nurture creative thinking skills.

Give children ample time to answer questions; if required give additional prompts.

A good teacher avoids expecting "standard" reactions and "standard" actions from children as she knows that each child is unique.

Don't drill children with questions, create an environment where children can question.

Encourage and create opportunities for observation and thinking.
