TE WHARIKI

- We have adapted the Te Whairiki curriculum framework of the Government of New Zealand in our care and activities.
- The 4 principles and 5 strands in the curriculum ideally suited the core philosophy that would be rooted in our vision of a quality childcare. (Holistic Development, Family and Community, Relationships, Empowerment, Communication, Exploration, Contribution, Well-being and Belonging)



PIKLER METHOD

- And we train our staff on Pikler method of child care which is based on respect for children and their needs.
- Our staff is trained on Pikler method to understand the concept of unhurried quality care.
- This approach is based on renowned Hungarian pediatrician Emmo Pikler's research into gross motor development and emphasizes treating babies with respect, i.e. telling them what you are going to do before you do it encouraging them to participate in their own care and supporting them to solve their own problems.
- Another important aspect of their training is how to handle difficult children and for this they are trained in the Magda Gerber method of handling children.
